### **REGISTER WITH THE COLLEGE**

# NON-EU STUDENTS: REGISTER WITH THE IRISH IMMIGRATION SERVICE - ISD (Formerly know as "GNIB" and "INIS")

 Non-EU students are required to register with the Irish Immigration Service, normally within 90 days of their arrival in Ireland.

#### GET A PPS NUMBER (IRISH SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER)

It is a requirement for all graduating students to have a PPS Number, and you also need it if you want to get a part-time job in Ireland.

**IMPORTANT!** YOU CAN'T APPLY FOR A PPS NUMBER UNTIL YOU HAVE REGISTERED WITH IRISH IMMIGRATION
