COURSE RELEVANCE

This programme is one of the mandatory courses required by the Police Licensing & Regulatory Department (PLRD) for a Security Officer (SO) prior to deployment at any premises.

Review different types of incident scenarios or responses based on organisational procedures and its appropriate reporting procedures

Perform security reporting procedures using mobile devices

Handle incidents involving damaged facilities or equipment

Attend to medical and first-aid needs while minimising risks of further injuries
