

## INTRODUCTION

Prospect Protection's Provide Guard and Patrol Services & Operate Basic Security Equipment (PGPS & OBSE) course covers the knowledge, skills and attitudes required of a security personnel to manage security incidents and services at deployment sites. Learners will also be able to attain knowledge and capabilities to handle security irregularities or emergencies efficiently and effectively at clients' premises.

# **COURSE RELEVANCE**

This programme is one of the three mandatory courses required by the Police Licensing Regulatory Department (PLRD) to be a licensed Security Officer (SO) prior to deployment at any premises.

Objective of the course is for participants prepare themselves for work activities, static guard roles, handle telephone calls, lost and found items, patrolling of premises, make relevant reports and handing over duties within the time given with the aid of the materials, tools & equipment given.

Furthermore, the course aims to equip the security officers with essential knowledge & skills to operate basic security equipment's such as access control, alarm monitoring system and closed-circuit television (CCTV) monitoring equipment.
